Order these steps in each outcome area from the first to the last skill developed

Outcome #1: Plays with Others

a. Participates in coordinated play with others	
 Reaches out to other children – touches, pats, may hit or pull hair 	
c. Participates in play with other children doing similar activities for a short time	
d. Looks at other children playing	

Outcome #2: Learning about Toys in Play

a. Engages in pretend play with toys and materials	
 b. Shows understanding of toys' aspects – color awareness, matching 	
 c. Experiments with banging, dropping, and repeating actions on toys 	
d. Uses a variety of toys in intended manner	
e. Mouths toys in exploration	



Outcome #3: Self-care (dressing, undressing, feeding, toileting)

a. Eats thick food with spoon, spilling often	
 Feeds self with spoon all the time with limited spilling 	
c. Picks up spoon by handle	
d. Uses spoon successfully most of the time, spills some	
e. Uses fork one-handed
