<b>Outcome #3: Use of appropriate behaviors to meet their needs</b>	<b>VA Milestone Indicators</b>	<b>Functional Outcomes:</b> Skills needed to successfully participate in routines with family members and peers	<b>Correlating Test Items</b>
<p>1. Taking care of basic needs (e.g., showing hunger, dressing, feeding, toileting)</p> <p>2. Contributing to own health and safety (e.g., following rules, assisting with hand washing, avoiding inedible objects)</p> <p>3. Getting from place to place (mobility) and using tools (e.g., utensils, strings attached to objects)</p>
